



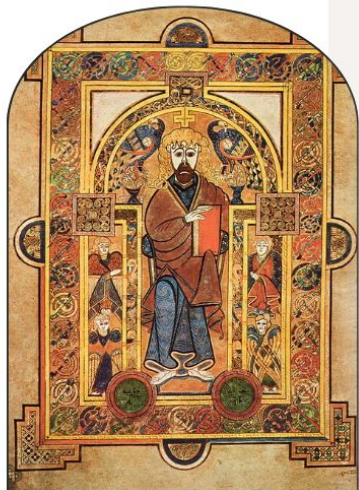
## Pilgrimage to Ireland & Medjugorje with Father David Skillman May 31 - June 11, 2027

Join **Father David Skillman** on a transformative 12-day spiritual journey from **May 31 to June 11, 2027**, tracing the sacred roots of the "**Isle of Saints and Scholars**" before arriving at the **peaceful village of Medjugorje**. This pilgrimage offers a profound encounter with the Communion of Saints, from the incorrupt relics of Irish martyrs to the apparition sites of the Queen of Peace. Participants will experience the Eucharistic heart of the Church through daily Mass at historic shrines like **Knock and St. James Church**. It is more than a tour of ancient stones; it is an invitation to entrust your intentions to the **Immaculate Heart of Mary** and renew your commitment to the Gospel. Together, we will walk in the footsteps of **St. Patrick and the Franciscan martyrs**, seeking personal conversion and peace for our world.



### Day 1: Monday, May 31, 2027 – Departure

Pilgrims depart from their home cities and board the overnight transatlantic flight to Dublin, Ireland. As the wheels lift off, each participant is invited to entrust the entire pilgrimage to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, offering every moment, joy, and sacrifice for the conversion of souls, the intentions of the Holy Father, and the triumph of the Gospel in our troubled world. This journey is not merely a tour of ancient stones but a living encounter with the Communion of Saints who have gone before us in faith. **Meals** are served on board the flight, nourishing body and soul as the pilgrimage truly begins.



### Day 2: Tuesday, June 1, 2027 – Arrival in Dublin

Upon arrival in Dublin, the group enjoys a prayerful orientation drive through the historic streets of Ireland's capital — a city sanctified by centuries of martyrs, monks, and missionaries who kept the Catholic Faith alive during persecution. A warm welcome awaits with tea and traditional scones, evoking the hospitality of Irish monastic tradition. The pilgrimage continues to **Trinity College** to reverence the sacred **Book of Kells**, the magnificent 9th-century illuminated manuscript of the Four Gospels, hand-copied by Irish monks as an act of profound love for the Word of God and a testament to Ireland's role as the "Isle of Saints and Scholars." A drive-by tour reveals other landmarks of Ireland's Catholic soul before arriving at the **Shrine of St. Valentine** in Whitefriar Street Church, where the relics of the 3rd-century martyr and patron of love are enshrined. Here pilgrims may venerate the saint who gave his life for Christ and request his intercession for holy marriages and pure love in our modern age. The opportunity for **Holy Mass** is offered either at the shrine or at the nearby **Pro Cathedral**, the mother church of the Archdiocese of Dublin, uniting the group in the Holy Sacrifice that links heaven and earth. The day concludes with hotel check-in. **(B, D) Overnight: Dublin**

### Day 3: Wednesday, June 2, 2027 – Dublin to Belfast

The morning opens with **Holy Mass** at the **Pro Cathedral** or **St. Kevin's Church** in Dublin, where pilgrims unite their hearts to the Eucharistic Lord before traveling north through the emerald countryside once evangelized by St. Patrick himself. In Drogheda, the group venerates the incorrupt head and relics of **St. Oliver Plunkett**, the 17th-century Archbishop of Armagh who was martyred at Tyburn in 1681 for refusing to renounce the Catholic Faith during the brutal penal laws — a powerful witness of fidelity unto death that still strengthens the Church today. The journey continues to **St. Brigid's Shrine** at Faughart, the ancient birthplace and burial place of Ireland's beloved patroness, the 5th-century abbess whose double monastery at Kildare became a beacon of learning, charity, and Eucharistic devotion across Europe. Pilgrims then reach **Down Cathedral** in Downpatrick to venerate the relics of **St. Patrick**, the great Apostle of Ireland, who, after being enslaved as a youth, returned as a bishop to convert a pagan nation through the power of the Cross. Time is set aside to pray in the small church traditionally linked to St. Patrick's early ministry and to visit the local museum that vividly recounts his missionary legacy of courage and conversion. A light lunch is enjoyed en route. The day ends with hotel check-in followed by dinner at a local restaurant. **(B, D) Overnight: Belfast**

#### Day 4: Thursday, June 3, 2027 – Belfast to Sligo

After breakfast, the pilgrimage travels to **St. Patrick's Catholic Cathedral** in Armagh — the primatial see of All Ireland — for **Holy Mass** and a guided tour. This majestic cathedral stands on the very hill where St. Patrick built his first stone church in the 5th century, making it the spiritual heart of Irish Catholicism for over 1,500 years. The group then pauses at the **Garden of Celtic Saints**, a tranquil sanctuary honoring the countless holy men and women whose lives of prayer, penance, and scholarship preserved Western civilization during the Dark Ages. A short lunch is followed by a deeply moving boat tour on **Lough Derg**, the site of St. Patrick's Purgatory — one of the oldest continuously operating penitential pilgrimages in the world, where countless souls have fasted, prayed, and experienced profound conversion through the intercession of Ireland's patron saint. The day concludes with hotel check-in. **(B, D) Overnight: Sligo**



#### Day 5: Friday, June 4, 2027 – Sligo to Galway

The morning begins at **Ballintubber Abbey** for Holy Mass in this extraordinary 13th-century church—the only church in Ireland to have offered the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass every day since 1216. Even through the Reformation and Cromwell's destruction, the "Abbey that refused to die" survived through the hidden fidelity of the faithful. Following Mass, the group will enjoy **lunch** nearby, refueling for the afternoon's spiritual journey. Next, the pilgrimage leads to **Croagh Patrick**, Ireland's holiest mountain, where St. Patrick fasted and prayed for forty days and nights in 441 AD to win the conversion of Ireland. Pilgrims have the opportunity to climb the sacred path or pray at its base, uniting their own intentions with the saint's powerful intercession for the Church. The day concludes at the breathtaking **Kylemore Abbey**, a Benedictine monastery founded in 1920 as a refuge for Irish nuns fleeing Belgium during World War I. Set against a dramatic backdrop of mountains and lakes, this "castle of the Immaculate Conception" remains a radiant center of consecrated life and devotion to Our Lady. The group then checks into their hotel in **Galway**, which serves as the base for the next three nights. **(B, D)**



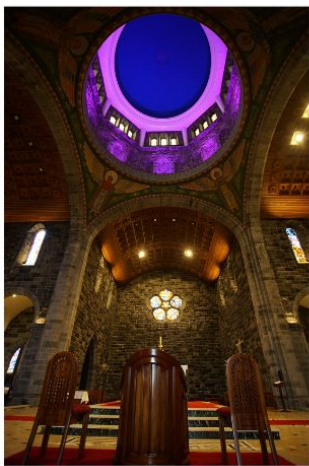
#### Day 6: Saturday, June 5, 2027 – Excursions from Galway

A scenic drive along the shores of **Galway Bay** brings the group to **Holy Mass** at **St. John the Baptist Church** in Ballyvaughan, a humble yet grace-filled parish church where the faithful gather to worship the Lord who still calls disciples by the sea. The pilgrimage then proceeds to the majestic **Cliffs of Moher**, where the dramatic Atlantic coastline proclaims the glory of God the Creator and invites deep contemplation of His majesty and the vastness of His mercy. A light lunch is enjoyed before exploring the otherworldly karst limestone of **the Burren**, where rare Arctic and Mediterranean flora thrive in a prehistoric "rocky place" that feels more like the moon than County Clare. This itinerary guides you from the ancient Poul nabrone Dolmen to the subterranean wonders of the Aillwee Caves, perfectly balancing Ireland's Neolithic archaeology with its raw, wind-sculpted Atlantic beauty. It is a surreal landscape that proves Ireland's rocky soul is just as enchanting as its famous rolling green hills. The group returns to the hotel in the evening. **(B, D) Overnight: Galway**



### Day 7: Sunday, June 6, 2027 – Excursions from Galway

The spiritual summit of the Irish portion of the pilgrimage is the visit to the **Shrine of Our Lady of Knock**, where on August 21, 1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist, and the Lamb of God appeared on the gable of the parish church in silent testimony during a time of great suffering in Ireland. No words were spoken — only the powerful language of presence — reminding the world that Mary's maternal intercession is always with her children in their trials. Pilgrims participate in **Holy Mass** in the **Apparition Chapel** built on the exact site of the heavenly visitation, followed by a guided tour, personal devotions, and time for quiet prayer before the sacred gable. Lunch is on own, allowing each soul to linger in Mary's presence. The group returns to Galway for free time to explore the city's churches, shops, and pubs while reflecting on the graces received. Dinner is on your own tonight. **(B) Overnight: Galway**



### Day 8: Monday, June 7, 2027 – Galway to Portmarnock

The morning begins with **Holy Mass** and a guided tour of the magnificent **Galway Cathedral**, dedicated to Our Lady Assumed into Heaven and St. Nicholas. Consecrated in 1965, its majestic mosaic of the Crucifixion and rose window invite pilgrims to contemplate the Paschal Mystery at the heart of our faith. The pilgrimage then journeys to the ancient monastic site of **Clonmacnoise**, founded by St. Ciaran in 548 AD on the banks of the River Shannon. Once a great center of learning that sent missionaries across Europe, its high crosses, round towers, and ruined churches stand as silent witnesses to Ireland's golden age of holiness and the enduring power of monastic prayer. The group checks into the hotel in Portmarnock. Farewell dinner to Ireland **(B, D) Overnight: Portmarnock**

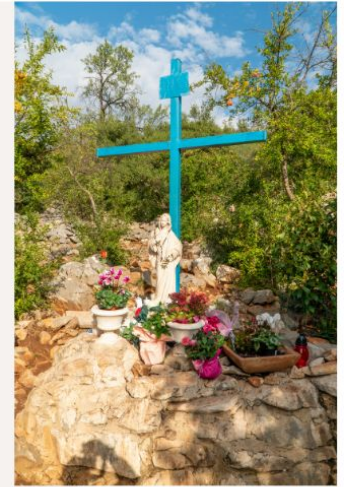
### Day 9: Tuesday, June 8, 2027 – Ireland to Medjugorje

After breakfast, the group transfers to Dublin Airport for the flight to Split or Dubrovnik. Croatia. Upon arrival at **the International Airport**, pilgrims are warmly welcomed by their professional English-speaking tour escort. If flight schedules and time permit, the group enjoys a panoramic and walking tour of historic Split, focusing on the remarkable **Diocletian's Palace**, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the best-preserved examples of late ancient Roman architecture. Built at the turn of the 4th century by the Emperor Diocletian — the last great persecutor of Christians — this imperial palace later became the foundation of a vibrant Catholic city. Its mausoleum was converted in the 7th century into the **Cathedral of Saint Domnius**, one of the oldest Catholic cathedrals in the world still in use in its original structure. Here, the relics of St. Domnius, the bishop-martyr beheaded under Diocletian's orders in 304 AD, are venerated — a profound symbol of the triumph of the Cross over pagan persecution. The palace itself stands as a living witness to how God can transform even the works of His enemies into instruments of grace and places of worship. **Holy Mass** is celebrated at a local church (subject to confirmation and time permitting), allowing pilgrims to offer the Eucharistic Sacrifice in this historic Christian heartland before continuing their journey. The group then boards the coach for the scenic transfer to Medjugorje. Upon arrival in this peaceful village chosen by Heaven, pilgrims check into the hotel and gather for dinner. **(B, D) Overnight: Medjugorje**



### Day 10: Wednesday, June 9, 2027 – Medjugorje

The day is entirely centered on the Mother of God, Queen of Peace. After breakfast at the hotel, pilgrims celebrate **Holy Mass** at **St. James Church**, the spiritual heart of Medjugorje. Consecrated in 1969 and placed under the patronage of St. James the Greater — patron saint of pilgrims — this church was built far larger than the small parish seemed to require. No one understood why until June 24, 1981, when the Blessed Virgin Mary began appearing to six young visionaries, drawing millions of pilgrims from around the world to this place of grace. The church has since become a beacon of sacramental life, where countless souls encounter Jesus in the Eucharist, Confession, and Adoration. In the morning or early afternoon (weather dependent and subject to confirmation), the group climbs **Apparition Hill (Podbrdo)**, following the same rocky path where the six visionaries first encountered Our Lady on that historic summer evening in 1981. Pilgrims pray at the statue marking the exact spot of the first apparitions and reflect on Mary’s gentle yet urgent call: “I have come to tell you that God exists and that He loves you.” At the base of the hill stands the **Blue Cross**, erected to commemorate the site of many subsequent apparitions, including those when the young visionaries hid from communist police in the early days of the apparitions. This peaceful spot continues to be a place of profound encounter with the Queen of Peace. **Please note:** Climbing Apparition Hill requires physical fitness. Pilgrims should wear comfortable walking shoes, bring water, and dress according to the weather. Lunch is on own, allowing time for personal reflection. In the evening, the group joins local villagers and thousands of pilgrims in the rich evening prayer program at **St. James Church**, which includes the Rosary, **Holy Mass**, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, opportunities for Confession (with over 60 confessionals available), and the special Blessing of the Sick. This powerful program embodies Our Lady’s five key messages: peace, conversion, prayer, fasting, and Holy Mass. Dinner is served at the hotel. **(B, D) Overnight: Medjugorje**



### Day 11: Thursday, June 10, 2027 – Medjugorje Excursion to Siroki Brijeg

After breakfast, the group drives to **Siroki Brijeg**, home of the heroic **Franciscan monastery** and a profound site of 20th-century martyrdom. On February 7, 1945, communist soldiers stormed the friary, declaring “God is dead... there is no God, no Pope, no Church.” They ordered the thirty Franciscan friars to remove their habits and renounce their faith. The friars refused. One soldier threw a crucifix to the ground, demanding they choose life or death. Each friar knelt, embraced the Cross, and declared, “You are my God and my All.” They were then taken out, slaughtered, and their bodies burned in a nearby cave. Today their remains rest inside the Franciscan church — a powerful witness of fidelity to Christ even unto death. Thousands of pilgrims visit each year to honor these martyrs whose blood continues to cry out for the faith they defended. **Holy Mass** is celebrated at Siroki Brijeg (subject to confirmation), uniting the group with this “cloud of witnesses” and asking for the grace of similar courage in our own time. Lunch is on own. The group returns to Medjugorje for a free afternoon dedicated to prayer and reflection — an ideal time for Eucharistic Adoration, the Sacrament of Confession, climbing **Cross Mountain**, or simply resting in the maternal presence of Our Lady. The day concludes with dinner at the hotel. **(B, D) Overnight: Medjugorje**



## Day 12: Friday, June 11, 2027 – Departure

After breakfast and hotel check-out, a final **Holy Mass** is celebrated at **St. James Church** in Medjugorje (subject to confirmation and time permitting), sealing the abundant graces of this pilgrimage in the Most Blessed Sacrament. The group then transfers to the Airport to begin the journey home, carrying in their hearts the intercession of Our Lady of Medjugorje, the powerful protection of the Irish saints, the example of the Franciscan martyrs, and a renewed commitment to live as true disciples of Jesus Christ — messengers of peace, conversion, and hope in today's world. **(B)**
