


Footsteps of Paul with Father Thomas Molini June 8th - 19th, 2026



MONDAY

June 8, 2026

Depart our home city on the international flight to Athens. Dinner & breakfast served aboard the flight

TUESDAY June 9. 2026


We arrive at 11:10 AM at Athens International airport. Here we will meet with our English-speaking Tour Manager and transfer to Athens City Center for our opening Mass at Catholic Cathedral Basilica of St Dionysius the Areopagiete. After, we have lunch, then take a panoramic drive of Athens. Following, we will check into our hotel to refresh ourselves before we transfer to a Restaurant with an Acropolis View for a Welcome Dinner. Overnight Athens

WEDNESDAY

June 10, 2026

After breakfast, we depart to **Ancient Corinthia.** (Acts 18.1-18). It was in ancient Corinth where Paul came and worked, established a thriving church and wrote two of the Epistles, which are now part of the New Testament. We will see all the sites that are associated with his ministry: **the Agora**, **the Temple of Apollo**, **the Roman Odeon**, **the Bema and Gallio's Seat**, **the Pillars**, **Stairs**, **and the place of public worship**, **where Paul preached**. This visit will certainly enhance our understanding of Corinthians I and II. In Corinth, **we Celebrate Mass outside**. After lunch we return to Athens for a sightseeing tour. We will go on a city tour where we will visit the main points of interest in the city: Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Royal Palace, Pan-Athenian Stadium, the Temple of Olympian Zeus and visit the world famous Acropolis, as well as Monastiraki (the Old Flea Market) and Mars' Hill (Areopagus) where Paul preached the truth to the Gentile Nation. Overnight Athens. (B & D)





Breakfast at hotel and check-out. We depart towards Delphi. Delphi is the location of the famous oracle where the priestess of Apollo, the Pythia influenced with her prophecies the history of cities and states of antiquity. We will visit the archaeological site and the museum. The museum contains an impressive collection associated with ancient Delphi, including the earliest known notation of a melody, the famous Charioteer, plus the golden treasures discovered beneath the Sacred Way, and fragments of reliefs from the Siphnian Treasury. Close to the exit is the inscription that mentions the Roman proconsul Gallio. The reference to Proconsul Gallio in the inscription provides an important marker for developing a chronology of the life of Apostle Paul by relating it to the trial of Paul in Achaea mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (18:12-17). As we depart for Kalambaka, we pass through Thermopylae where we learn of the famous Spartan battle of 300. Arriving late in the afternoon for dinner and overnight. (Mass in Athens before departing for Kalambaka) Overnight Kalambaka (B & D)

June 11, 2026

After breakfast, we will visit the spectacular Meteora, the UNESCO World Heritage Site, which is a mountainous region of stunning scenery. We will see centuries old Byzantine monasteries on top of huge rocks, first built in the 14th century by monks seeking isolation and salvation. We will visit two monasteries, where we admire impressive icons, old manuscripts, unique mosaics and frescoes. After, we depart to Veria (Berea), another town evangelized by Paul (Acts 17.10-14). When Saint Paul visited this town in AD50, he came across a more noble Jewish community where he preached and created an important Church. This is where Paul met Sopatros, who would later become a valuable partner who followed him on his return journey to Asia. We will visit the ancient synagogue where we will see the Byzantine mosaic in the monument commemorating his preaching. According to tradition it was at this place where he preached. We celebrate Mass at Veria. Then we will head to Vergina, the legendary burial site of the Macedonian kings. This place is considered a World Heritage Site, also known as the Royal Tombs and houses the tomb of King Philip II, father of Alexander the Great. He was conqueror of Greek territories which resulted in the expansion of Hellenism. After, we depart to Thessaloniki for hotel check-in and dinner. (B & D)





After breakfast, we depart for a day trip to **Philippi**, the town where Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, sowing the seeds of Christianity. "And from there (He went) to Philippi, which is the leading city of the district of Macedonia and a Roman Colony. We remained in this city some days..." (Acts 16:12-18). Paul arrived here with Silas and Luke on the winter of AD 49 to AD50. There the first Christian baptism was performed, of a woman named Lydia. Here we have Mass. Although they were prosecuted and arrested, they received God's help to escape from prison (Acts 16: 11-23) where there was the conversion of the jailer (Acts 16: 23-26). We will visit the Roman Theatre and the probable site of the prison where Paul and Silas were arrested. We will continue towards the city of Kavala and the ancient city of Neapolis (Acts 16:11) where Paul landed with his disciples, Timothy and Silas. It was later renamed Christoupolis, meaning city of God, because it was the first European city to accept Christianity. We will visit the Roman Aqueduct and the ruins of the Acropolis. We then return to Thessaloniki late in the afternoon for dinner and overnight. Overnight Thessaloniki

SATURDAY

June 13, 2026

After breakfast we check out of the hotel and Celebrate an early Mass at the Catholic Chapel of Saint Vincent de Paul or Church of the Immaculate Conception. The trip continues with exploring the city of Thessaloniki where Paul preached the Gospel in the second and third missionary journeys. For the early Christians of this city he wrote the Epistles "To the Thessalonians". We will visit the Cathedral of St Demetrius, the Protector Saint of the city, the church of Agia Sofia, the White Tower and the Byzantine Fortress of the city. After lunch, we depart to Athens and arrive late in the afternoon. Tonight we delight in a dinner at a restaurant with Music. Overnight in Athens

Before embarking on a wonderful **4-night cruise to the Greek Islands and Turkey, we will Celebrate Mass at the Church of Saint Barbara near the Athens Port. Mykonos**, the whitewashed jewel of the Cyclades Islands, is our first stop. This charming, mountainous island is known for the hundreds of tiny chapels, white-washed buildings and beautiful windmills that dot its landscape. Don't miss taking a stroll down the Mykonos Town, where mazes of narrow streets link the whitewashed buildings and traditional life continues amidst the bustling activity. Here, we enjoy free time to explore this little paradise in the middle of the Aegean Sea. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are served daily while on board. **(B, L & D)**



After an early breakfast, we stop at **Kusadasi**, **Turkey**, **and visit the ancient ruins of Ephesus**, a Greek colony founded by Athenians. Walk down a marble road, worn by chariot wheels, past architectural marvels like the **Magnesian Gate**, **Library of Celsus**, **and Great Amphitheater**, **where Paul preached (Acts 20:31)**. During AD 52-54, Paul lived here, wrote the First Epistle to the Corinthians, and organized missionary work. Ephesus, one of the seven churches in Revelation (Acts 2:1-7), had a strong early Christian community. **We then visit the House of Virgin Mary**, **where she lived with John**, **and celebrate Mass**. Returning to the cruise ship for lunch, we sail to **Patmos**, a spiritual island where St. John the Theologian was exiled in 95 AD. He lived in a cave, now **the Holy Grotto of the Revelation**, where he wrote the Fourth Gospel and, with disciple Prochoros, transcribed the Book of Revelation. We also visit the UNESCO-listed **Monastery of St. John**. After reboarding, we sail to Rhodes, enjoying dinner onboard.

Arriving early at **Rhodes**, a stunning Mediterranean island known as the Island of the Roses, we explore its rich history, beautiful beaches, and vibrant shopping. The island blends medieval charm with colorful villages and dramatic landscapes. Rhodes City splits into the medieval old town and modern new city, featuring key sites like the Palace of the Grand Master, Hospital of the Knights, and Colloquium building. Visit the Acropolis of Lindos, an ancient city with the temple of Athena Lindia, Propylea, and Roman temple of Diocletian (optional guided tour or explore independently). **After, attend Mass at the Catholic Church on Rhodes**, then return to the port to reboard the ship and sail to Crete. **(B, L & D)**





In the morning the ship will dock at the port of Heraklion on the island of Crete. In Heraklion Paul met the owner and captain of the ship, who warned him about continuing his journey to Rome. Mass will be at the Catholic Church of St John the Baptist in Crete. You can take a tour (optional tour) to the Palace of Knossos, the center of the Minoan civilization. After lunch, the ship will travel to the most beautiful island in the Aegean Sea known as the "Black Pearl of the Aegean", the volcanic Santorini where we will enjoy the breathtaking Panoramic View. Latest excavations have suggested that Santorini might be the lost sight of Atlantis. Visit Oia Village (optional tour), an excellent example of Cycladic architecture. Explore the village walking along the cobble-stone streets and the white washed houses with blue shutters where one gets the impression that they are a beautiful travel poster. After, we are back on board the ship to set sail back to the port of Athens around 21:30. Overnight on board


