

Holy Face Pilgrimage

to Jordan and the Holy Land

October 16 – 30, 2027

Dear Friends in Christ,

Father Frank Furman of the Fraternity of St. Peter (FSSP) and Jule Lane, a devoted Holy Face Missionary, cordially invite you to this pilgrimage through Jordan and the Holy Land. Drawn from the **Holy Face devotion**—the veneration of the suffering countenance of Christ, inspired by the Veil of Veronica and cherished by saints such as St. Thérèse of Lisieux—this journey invites reparation, prayer, and a living encounter with the places where Christ walked, preached, suffered, and redeemed the world.

May the Holy Face of Jesus shine upon us as we walk in the footsteps of the Gospel.



October 16, 2027 — Saturday: Departure Day

As the sun sets on our home cities, the pilgrimage begins with an evening connecting flight to Amman, Jordan—the gateway to biblical lands where prophets once walked. Under the guidance of Father Furman and Jule Lane, settle into the rhythm of travel. Recite prayers of the Holy Face devotion and prepare your heart, as pilgrims have done since the early Church. Dinner and breakfast are served aboard the aircraft.



October 17, 2027 — Sunday: Arrival in Amman

Touch down at Amman Airport, clear customs, and enter Jordan's rich Christian heritage—communities that trace back to the Acts of the Apostles. Celebrate Holy Mass at the Martyrs of Jordan Catholic Church. Father Furman leads reflections on the Holy Face and Christ's hidden sufferings. Breakfast upon arrival and a welcoming dinner. Overnight at the Amman Marriott.

Spiritual theme: Reparation to the Holy Face of Jesus • Daily Mass • Guided prayer with Fr. Furman, FSSP & Jule Lane

October 18 — Monday: Madaba, Bethany, Mukawir & Petra



Travel south to Madaba and the famed 6th-century mosaic map in St. George's Church—an early Christian vision of the Holy Land. Celebrate Holy Mass at the Baptismal Site in Bethany beyond the Jordan, where St. John immersed Christ and the Trinity was revealed. Renew baptismal vows in this cradle of salvation history. Continue to Mukawir (Machaerus), the fortress where Herod Antipas imprisoned and beheaded the Baptist. Evening arrival in Petra, overnight at the Petra Marriott.

Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Baptismal Site, Bethany beyond the Jordan • Hotel: Petra Marriott



October 19 — Tuesday: Sacred Petra

Awaken in the rose-red city carved from sandstone, once a crossroads of trade along routes the Magi may have traveled. Holy Mass is celebrated at the hotel. Walk the Siq canyon to the Treasury, and explore tombs and monasteries. Reflect how this landscape—pagan, Nabatean, and later touched by early Christian presence—mirrors the Church's mission to sanctify the world, as the Desert Fathers sought God in solitude. Jule Lane guides conversation on the Holy Face as a beacon in desolate places. Overnight again at the Petra Marriott.

Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Petra Marriott • Hotel: Petra Marriott

October 20 — Wednesday: Mount Nebo, Tell Mar Elias & Mount Tabor

Ascend Mount Nebo, where Moses gazed upon the Promised Land (Deuteronomy). Celebrate Holy Mass at this Byzantine pilgrimage height, with ancient mosaics in the Franciscan church. Visit Tell Mar Elias, traditionally linked to Elijah's fiery ascent—patron of the Carmelites and a sign of the soul's heavenly journey. Cross the northern border into Galilee and climb Mount Tabor, site of the Transfiguration, visiting the Basilica that commemorates Christ's radiant glory. Overnight at Pilgerhaus on the Sea of Galilee.

Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Mount Nebo • Hotel: Pilgerhaus, Galilee



October 21 — Thursday: Nazareth, Mount Carmel & Haifa

In Nazareth, town of the Incarnation, celebrate Holy Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation, built over the grotto of Gabriel's greeting to Mary. Time permitting, join the Angelus procession. Journey to Mount Carmel in Haifa—where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal—now home to Stella Maris Monastery and the origins of the Carmelite Order. Receive the Brown Scapular investiture, a sacramental of Our Lady's protection, uniting contemplative prayer with the Holy Face devotion. Overnight at Pilgerhaus.



Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Basilica of the Annunciation • Hotel: Pilgerhaus

October 22 — Friday: Mount of Beatitudes, Sea of Galilee & Magdala

Atop the Mount of Beatitudes, overlooking the lake where Jesus preached, offer Holy Mass and meditate on the Beatitudes as a rule of Christian life. Visit Caesarea Philippi, site of Peter's confession; the Church of the Primacy of Peter; and Capernaum, the Lord's adopted home and synagogue. Enjoy a lunch of St. Peter's Fish and a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Conclude at Magdala, hometown of St. Mary Magdalene, with its first-century synagogue and the Boat Chapel fresco of the hemorrhaging woman healed by touching Christ's garment—an image of mercy that speaks to the Holy Face.

Breakfast, lunch (St. Peter's Fish), and dinner included • Mass: Mount of Beatitudes • Hotel: Pilgerhaus



October 23 — Saturday: Tabgha, Jordan Valley & Jericho



Pray at Tabgha, site of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes—a miracle that foreshadows the Eucharist. Drive the fertile Jordan Valley, passing Beit She'an's Roman ruins. In Jericho, the world's oldest city and the scene of Joshua's conquest, explore biblical sites over lunch at El Rawada. Holy Mass this morning at Capernaum or Tabgha. Evening transfer to Bethlehem, birthplace of the Savior. Overnight at Heritage Bethlehem.

Breakfast, lunch in Jericho, and dinner included • Mass: Capernaum or Tabgha • Hotel: Heritage Bethlehem



October 24 — Sunday: Bethlehem's Sacred Mysteries



In Bethlehem, where the Word became flesh, celebrate Holy Mass at the Shepherds' Fields, recalling the angels' announcement to humble watchmen. Visit the Church of the Nativity—raised by Constantine over the cave of Christ's birth—the Grotto of St. Jerome, where the Vulgate was translated, and the Church of St. Catherine. Time permitting, join the Franciscan procession to the manger. Lunch with local Christian families strengthens solidarity with the living Church of the Holy Land.

Breakfast, lunch with Christian families (or Casa Nova), and dinner included • Mass: Shepherds' Fields • Hotel: Heritage Bethlehem



October 25 — Monday: Bethany, the Jordan, Masada & the Dead Sea

In Bethany of Lazarus, Mary, and Martha, visit the Church of St. Lazarus and celebrate Holy Mass in the Crusader church—recalling the miracle that prefigured the Resurrection. Renew baptismal promises at the Jordan River. Continue to Masada's desert fortress and Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls illuminated Scripture and early Church texts. Floating in the Dead Sea becomes a quiet sign of spiritual buoyancy. Overnight at Notre Dame in Jerusalem.

Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Crusader Church of St. Lazarus, Bethany • Hotel: Notre Dame, Jerusalem



October 26 — Tuesday: Mount of Olives, Gethsemane & Ein Karem

From the Mount of Olives, visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Church of the Pater Noster. Celebrate Holy Mass at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem—a place to contemplate the sorrowing Holy Face. Descend to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. In Ein Karem, honor the Visitation and the birth of St. John the Baptist. Close at the Israel Museum. Overnight at Notre Dame.

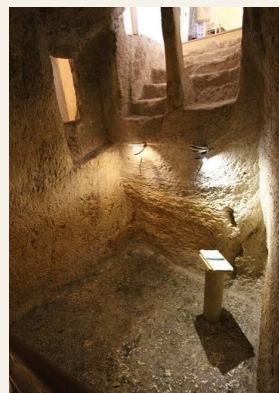
Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: Dominus Flevit • Hotel: Notre Dame, Jerusalem



October 27 — Wednesday: Passion Sites & Holy Hour

Celebrate Holy Mass at St. Peter in Gallicantu, site of Peter's denial and the house of Caiaphas. Trace the Passion through the Upper Room of the Last Supper—where the Eucharist was instituted—and Dormition Abbey, honoring Our Lady's Assumption. Pass the Western Wall and tour the City of David: Hezekiah's Tunnel and First Temple—period excavations. After dinner, a Holy Hour at the Church of All Nations in Gethsemane. The Holy Face shines in these places of betrayal and fidelity.

Breakfast and dinner included • Mass: St. Peter in Gallicantu • Hotel: Notre Dame



October 28 — Thursday: Via Dolorosa & the Holy Sepulchre

Rise early for the Way of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa—the Franciscan path of Christ's steps to Calvary. Enter the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, encompassing Golgotha and the Tomb, Christianity's holiest shrine since St. Helena. Holy Mass at the Sacred Tomb or Calvary. Visit the Church of St. Anne. Possible Franciscan procession. Free time and a farewell dinner on the Notre Dame rooftop.

Breakfast and rooftop farewell dinner included • Mass: Sacred Tomb or Calvary • Hotel: Notre Dame



October 29 — Friday: Emmaus, Deir Rafat & Jaffa — Journey Home

Celebrate Holy Mass at Abu Ghosh Monastery, a proposed Emmaus where the Risen Lord was known in the breaking of the bread—an active Benedictine house and a Eucharistic mystery at the heart of Catholic faith. Visit Deir Rafat, shrine of Our Lady Queen of Palestine, then Jaffa and St. Peter's Church, recalling the apostle's vision and the raising of Tabitha. Early dinner at St. George, Jaffa, then transfer for a late-night departure from Tel Aviv.

Breakfast and early dinner included • Mass: Abu Ghosh Monastery (Emmaus)



October 30 — Saturday: Return Home

Arrive in the United States, clear customs, and connect homeward. Meals aboard. Carry the pilgrimage's graces—and the Holy Face contemplated in the lands of salvation history—back to family, parish, and daily life.

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT

Travel Tyme requires a deposit of \$400 per person sent with the application at booking. This deposit forms part of your final payment, which must be received no later than 65 days prior to departure. Seats are limited on this pilgrimage, so we suggest an early booking.

CANCELLATIONS

Please make all cancellations in writing. If cancelled 120 days or more prior to departure, a \$75 administration fee is charged. If cancelled 119–61 days prior, a \$300 penalty will be charged. If cancelled 60 days or fewer prior, no money is refunded. In addition, once airline tickets are issued (about 90 days prior to departure), **the air cost is non-refundable.**

TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance to recuperate the penalties charged for cancellation for health reasons. You would be fully covered, except if pre-existing conditions are evident. Even so, the insurer waives the exclusion for pre-existing conditions if insurance is purchased within 15 days of deposit received by Travel Tyme.

PASSPORT AND VISA

A valid passport is required for all U.S. citizens traveling to Jordan and Israel. Passports should remain valid at least six months beyond the return date. For those holding passports of other countries, visas may be required. Please check with Travel Tyme. Border-crossing procedures between Jordan and Israel are part of this itinerary.
