Sunday June 8: This morning we depart St. Louis, Missouri on our 4:05 PM flight that connects through Toronto, then on to Madrid. Dinner and breakfast is served on the international flight.



Monday June 9: We arrive in Madrid at 6:00 AM. After we pass through passport control, we gather our luggage and meet our in-county tour manager. We are then escorted to our motor coach, where our luggage is loaded. In earnest, our Pilgrimage begins! Today we will have a guided visit to Madrid. We will visit the **Old Quarter, known as El Madrid de los Austrias (or The Madrid of the Austrians)**. This is a historic area built during the reign of the Habsburg Dynasty (1516-1700), also referred to as the Casa de Austria. It's located south of Calle Mayor, nestled between the Sol and Ópera Metro stations. Picture narrow streets, centuries-old buildings, and lampposts adorned with carvings that tell stories of bullfights, markets, coronations, and even executions. We also view **La Real Oratorio del Caballero de Gracia**. And will also learn about the apparition of Our Lady to Sister Patrocinio. Sister Patrocinio (Dolores Quiroga) (1811-1891) On August 31, 1831, the Virgin Mary appeared in the house of Dolores Quiroga, the Franciscan foundress of thirty convents throughout Spain, with the stigmata, nicknamed the "Nun of Wounds"; She appeared again in the convent of the Conceptionists where she lived. Antoine-Marie Claret was her spiritual director. Her cause for beatification was introduced in 1907. We also visit **Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor and Cathedral of Santa María la Real de la Almudena, where our opening Mass for the Pilgrimage will be held**. After that, we drive to our hotel to checkin for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday June 10: After breakfast, we travel to Nieva and explore this quaint town. Here we visit **Monastery Santa María la Real with the Church of Nuestra Señora de la Soterraña**. We are told that Mary appeared to a shepherd and asked him to ask the local bishop to dig up an icon. The bishop listened to the shepherd and the portrait was found. Indeed, in the place indicated by the shepherd, had been buried in ancient times an original first-century Christian wooden portrait of Mother of God on the throne. **Queen Catherine of Castile erected a shrine that is maintained by the Dominicans**. Before lunch in Segovia, we stop at the **Pradera San Marcos**. After, we continue to Avila and visit the **Old Quarter and the Convent of St. Teresa de Avila and Monastery de La Encarnación**. We learn about **St. Teresa of Avila**, this Reformer and Doctor and the impact she had on our Church. Here we will **Celebrate Mass in the Transverberation Chapel at the Incarnation Monastery in Ávila**. After, we return to our hotel in Madrid for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, June 11: After breakfast, we check out of our hotel and then go to the **Basílica Pontificia de San Miguel for Mass**. We then travel to Agreda. After our 3 hour journey, we will have lunch first. After, we will have a guided visit to Agreda. Here we see the **Old Quarter with Convento de las Madres Concepcionistas with the incorrupt body of Ven. Mary of Ágreda, Museo de Arte Sacro in the former church of Nuestra Señora de la Peña and the Church Our Lady of the Miracles** (with the baptismal font). After, we continue to Zaragoza where check into our hotel and have dinner.

Thursday June 12: After breakfast we make our way to **the Basilica of Our Lady of El Pilar in Zaragoza to Celebrate Mass**. Our Lady of the Pillar is one of the oldest Marian invocations. According to tradition, when the Mother of Jesus was still living in Jerusalem, Saint James the Greater saw her arrive in mortal flesh on the banks of the Ebro River, accompanied by a group of angels carrying a column. This Basilica commemorates the appearance of Our Lady to St James as he preached in Spain. We then have a tour of the **Zaragoza Old Quarter** as well as the Basilica. After lunch we go to **Arantzazu** and visit the Sanctuary. **The Sanctuary of Our Lady of Arantzazu**



is a Franciscan sanctuary located in Oñati, Basque Country, Spain. The shrine is dedicated to the Virgin of Arantzazu being the sanctuary's namesake and patron saint of the province along with **Saint Ignatius of Loyola**. After our guided visit we continue to Bilbao for dinner and overnight in our hotel.

Friday, June 13: This morning we have a guided visit to Bilbao. Here we visit the Old Quarter, San Antonio Church and the Basilica of Begona where we Celebrate Mass. Our Lady of Begoña celebrates an apparition of the Virgin Mary at the site of the Basilica of Begoña, in Bilbao, Spain. Affectionately called "Amatxu", she is said to have appeared to local people in the early 16th century. The feast day of Our Lady of Begoña is October 11th. After a light lunch, we travel to Ampuero where we are escorted to the Sanctuary La Bien Aparecida. The chronicles say that, at the beginning of the 17th century, there was a small hermitage dedicated to San Marcos in that place; and also that on September 15, 1605 they found a small image of the Virgin in one of its windows. No one ever knew the previous history of that carving. It was only known that the locals picked it up from that window and reverently placed it inside the hermitage, and that, since then, more and more people came to that hermitage to pray to Mary before that image. A pilgrimage center that emanates spirituality and mystery. After, we continue on to Santander where we check into a hotel for dinner and overnight.

Saturday, June 14: This morning we check out after breakfast and travel to Garabandal to discover the Garabandal apparitions. The apparitions of Saint Michael the Archangel and the Blessed Virgin Mary that occurred from 1961 to 1965 to four young schoolgirls in the rural village of San Sebastián de Garabandal in the Peña Sagra mountain range. The Virgin Mary in this series of visitations is often referred to as "Our Lady of Mount Carmel of Garabandal", because her appearance and dress looked like portrayals of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. We will climb to the spot of the Apparitions. After lunch in Llanes, a coastal village, we depart for the Cave of Our Lady of Covadonga. It was where Christian forces in Iberia defeated a Muslim army at the Battle of Covadonga, marking the beginning of the Spanish Reconquista. According to tradition, the cave was where Pelagius of Asturias, a Visigoth nobleman and founder of the Kingdom of Asturias, found a statue of the Virgin Mary that a hermit had erected. The statue then later miraculously helped his forces defeat their enemies. Here we Celebrate Mass. After, we make our way to León for dinner and overnight to our Hotel.

Sunday, June 15: Today we have a guided visit to León where we visit many of the historical sites and the Cathedral. After lunch, we make our way to La Virgen del Camino. Here we Celebrate MASS in the Sanctuary of La Virgen del Camino. The miraculously-located Shrine is outside the City of León on the Camino de Santiago, the pilgrim road to Compostela, hence the title "Virgin of the Way". The Virgen del Camino was declared Patron of the León region in 1914. After, we travel to Santiago de Compostela for dinner and overnight in the hotel. **NOTE:** depending on the day's schedule, participants could walk on the Camino en route to Santiago de Compostela.

Monday, June 16: Today we have a guided visit of Santiago de Compostela. We will visit the Old District and the Cathedral where St James the Apostle is interred. Father Lampe will Concelebrate the Pilgrim Mass in La Catedral de Santiago in the Morning. Later, we board our motor coach for a trip to Fatima. Along the way we will stop for lunch. Tonight after dinner we have the opportunity to participate in the Candle Light Procession & Rosary in Fatima.

Tuesday, June 17: This morning after breakfast we drive about 20 minutes to Santarem to Celebrate MASS in the Saint Stephen's Church. In the early 13th century, a woman with an

unfaithful husband sought help from a sorceress. The sorceress promised to cure her husband’s infidelity in exchange for a consecrated Host. Reluctantly, the woman stole the Host during Mass. As she left the church, the stolen host began to bleed—so much that it appeared as if she had cut her hand. Concerned parishioners tried to help, but she fled. The host was later solemnly returned to the Church of St. Stephen. Another miracle occurred when the wax container holding the host shattered, and the host was found enclosed in a crystal pyx. The Church approved the miracle, reinforcing the belief in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. After we return to Fatima to tour the complex with its **Basílica or Our Lady of the Rosary, VALINHOS** with the possibility to walk the **Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra** and **ALJUSTREL** visiting the Homes of the Shepherd children. **Today Father Lampe will also Concelebrate Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions “La Capelinha” in Fátima.** After dinner we can join the **Candlelight Procession and pray the Rosary in Fatima.**

Wednesday, June 18: After Breakfast, we Travel to Lisbon. We will have a guided visit of Lisbon that will include the **Cathedral and Church of St. Anthony. Here we Celebrate our final Mass of the Pilgrimage.** After Lunch, we will go to Belem for a guided tour of the Jerónimos Monastery and Belem Tower. Later, we return to Lisbon, where we will have a Farewell dinner.
