Pilgrimage to Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mexico With Father Anthony Ochoa May 25 - 29, 2026

Join **Father Anthony Ochoa** on this grace-filled 5-day pilgrimage to the heart of Mexico's Catholic heritage. Center your journey around the miraculous image of **Our Lady of Guadalupe**, Patroness of the Americas, while discovering the powerful witness of saints and blessed ones such as **St. Juan Diego**, **Blessed Miguel Pro**, and **Blessed Conchita Cabrera**. Daily **Mass**, prayer before the tilma, and visits to ancient sacred sites will deepen your faith and create memories to last a lifetime.



Monday, May 25, 2026 – Arrive in Mexico

This morning, make your way to your local airport for your flight(s) to Mexico City. We arrive midday and will go directly to a Church for Mass, then a quick panoramic of Mexico City on our way to the hotel. Tonight, you will have the pleasure of meeting and enjoying a dinner with your fellow pilgrims and staying overnight at the hotel.

D – Mexico City

Tuesday, May 26, 2026 – Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe - Teotihuacan

Today you will go to the **Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, the Patroness of the Americas. This Shrine was built in response to Our Lady's request to the apparition's seer, **St. Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin**. When **St. Juan** relayed her request to the bishop, he asked for a sign. Our Lady provided **St. Juan** with culturally significant flowers that miraculously bloomed in the middle of winter on Tepeyac Hill. When the seer returned to the bishop with his cloak (tilma) full of flowers, he poured the flowers on the floor, revealing a stunning image of Our Lady which many studies have proven could not have been made by human hand. Upon arrival at the **Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, you will celebrate **Mass** in the Indian Chapel. Following **Mass**, you will have





the opportunity to kneel in front of **St. Juan's** tilma, on which Our Lady's image was miraculously imprinted. Afterward we will continue to **San Juan Teotihuacan**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. According to mythology, this site was chosen to be the center of the universe and thus became a prominent political and religious center from the second century to the ninth century. While in **San Juan Teotihuacan**, you will enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant, followed by a guided tour of the archaeological zone. While on this tour, you will view the pyramids of the Sun and Moon, the Temple of Quetzalcoatl, and local art markets. Your incredible day will culminate with a **delicious dinner outside the hotel** before returning to the hotel.

B, L & D – Mexico City

Wednesday, May 27, 2026 – Mexico City - Blessed Miguel Pro – Santo Domingo Church - Blessed Conchita Cabrera

This morning after breakfast you will depart for **Holy Family Church**, where you will view the tomb of the Jesuit martyr, **Blessed Miguel Agustín Pro**. During the Mexican Revolution, **Fr. Pro** was exiled from Mexico due to the great amount of religious persecution. Yet he bravely returned to Mexico and was aided by a clandestine group that helped him hide from the authorities. He assisted many individuals with their spiritual and temporal needs during the persecution. Although he helped many, he was eventually arrested and killed. His final words before the firing squad were “Viva Cristo Rey!” which translates to “Long Live Christ the King!” At **Holy Family Church**, you can venerate this saint's relics and ask for his intercession. We will also celebrate **Mass** here and visit the small yet inspiring museum dedicated to **Fr. Pro's** life, mission, and sacrifice.

We will continue to the **Church of Santo Domingo**, which stands on the same site where the first temple was built after the conquest of the Dominicans. Inside the church, you will see several chapels, and you will have the opportunity to pray the rosary in the chapel dedicated to the Virgin of the Rosary. Next is the **Mexico City Metropolitan Cathedral**, dedicated to the Assumption of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, stands as a profound spiritual beacon for Catholic pilgrims, inviting them to reflect on centuries of faith built upon the ancient Aztec site in the heart of the Zócalo. As the oldest and largest cathedral in Latin America, completed in 1813 with its magnificent Gothic, Baroque, and Neoclassical architecture, it offers a sacred space for prayer, veneration of relics, and connection to the rich history of Mexican Catholicism during pilgrimages.

Next, we will have lunch near the city center before continuing to the **Church of San José del Altillo** to see the crypt where **Blessed Conchita Cabrera** is buried. **Blessed María Concepción Cabrera Arias de Armida**, known as **Conchita**, was a model of holiness as a wife, mother, widow, grandmother, and founder. Because of the depth of her writings, **Conchita** is recognized as a great mystic of the 20th century. In addition to her voluminous writings, **Conchita** founded several apostolates under the banner of “Works of the Cross.” Pope Saint John Paul II declared her Venerable on December 20, 1999, and Pope Francis confirmed a miracle that was attributed to **Conchita** on June 8, 2018. She was beatified in Mexico City on May 4, 2019. Time for prayers and personal devotions will be provided.

Your day will conclude with another delicious dinner outside the hotel before our overnight stay at the hotel.

B & D – Mexico City





Thursday, May 28, 2026 – Church of Tlupetlac - Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe

After breakfast, we will head to the **Church of the Fifth Apparition** in Tlupetlac, where the Blessed Virgin Maria de Guadalupe appeared to and healed **Juan Bernardino, Juan Diego's** uncle. On the fatal sickness and sudden healing of his uncle, Our Lady told **St. Juan**, "Listen, put it into your heart, my youngest and dearest son, that the thing that frightens you, the thing that afflicts you, is nothing: do not let it disturb you... Am I not here, I am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantle, in the crossing of my arms? Do you need something more? Let nothing else worry you or disturb you." Here you can find a well of healing water that locals drink from. You can pause at the well and reflect on the consoling words of our Mother Mary.

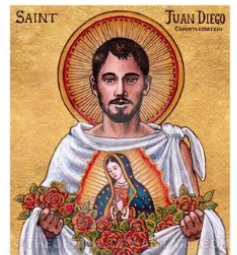
