





Monday, September 16: In your last walking day you will pass the Church of Lavacolla and continue your pilgrimage to Monte do Gozo from where the imposing Cathedral of Santiago can be contemplated. Lunch will be on your own. We arrive in Santiago de Compostela in northwestern Spain, a city that grew around the tomb of St. James the Apostle, whose apostolic mission to the Iberian Peninsula began its conversion to Christianity. In later centuries the Christians of Spain made St. James their patron saint as they strove to deliver the land from Moorish occupation. I Celebrate Mass in Santiago de Compostela or if possible in the Church of A Corticela.

Tuesday, September 17: The relics of St. James the Apostle are enshrined in the crypt located under the high altar of the city's great 11<sup>th</sup> century Romanesque Cathedral with its ornate Baroque façade. We celebrate our HOLY MASS in SANTIAGO CATHEDRAL. During the Middle Ages, when the Holy Land was not accessible for pilgrimages, millions of devout pilgrims trekked here from all over Europe. After Mass a guide gives us a tour, explaining the history of this important pilgrimage destination. For the rest of the day we can enjoy the unspoiled beauty of the Old Town.





## The Pilgrimage is guided and supported but you must be able to walk at least 10 miles per day. You must be able to complete under your own power.
