

Pilgrimage to Lourdes, Rome, and Assisi with Father Ryan Weber October 11 - 24, 2026

Join Father Ryan Weber on a transformative 14-day Catholic pilgrimage visiting Lourdes, Rome, and Assisi to deepen faith through sacred sites, daily Masses, and prayerful encounters. The journey begins in Lourdes with three nights of devotion at the Grotto, candlelight processions, and healing baths inspired by Our Lady's apparitions to St. Bernadette. In Rome, explore major basilicas like St. Peter's and St. Mary Major, Vatican Museums, ancient catacombs, and Attend the Angelus led by Pope Leo. Continue to Umbria for reflections on saints Benedict, Rita, Francis, and Clare in Cascia, Norcia, and Assisi, including monastic sites, a winery visit, and free time. Conclude in Orvieto venerating the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena before returning home renewed in spirit and fellowship.






October 11: The sacred pilgrimage commences with an overnight flight from the United States to Toulouse, France, where dinner and breakfast are served aboard, fostering a spirit of anticipation and prayer as pilgrims prepare to encounter the holy sites of Christendom.

October 12: Arriving in Toulouse, nestled near the serene Pyrenees foothills, pilgrims collect their luggage and meet their Tour Manager before boarding a motorcoach. As the coach weaves through the historic old town, the group learns of Toulouse's profound Catholic heritage, shaped by figures like St. Dominic, who founded the Order of Preachers here in the 13th century to combat heresy and spread the Gospel. The journey continues to the Tomb of St. Thomas Aquinas in the Basilica of Saint-Sernin, a Romanesque masterpiece and pilgrimage site on the Way of St. James. Here, Holy Mass is celebrated in reverence for the Angelic Doctor, whose theological works, including the *Summa Theologica*, continue to illuminate Catholic doctrine. Afterward, the group ascends the Pyrenees to Lourdes, checking into the hotel for dinner and participating in the evening's candlelight procession, a radiant act of devotion to Our Lady under her title of the Immaculate Conception. The group remains in Lourdes for three nights, immersed in prayer and spiritual renewal.

October 13: In Lourdes, where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858, pilgrims begin the day at 9:45 AM with Holy Mass at the sacred Grotto of Massabielle, the very site where Our Lady declared, "I am the Immaculate Conception," affirming the dogma proclaimed by Pope Pius IX in 1854. The miraculous spring, unearthed by St. Bernadette at Mary's instruction, has been a source of countless spiritual and physical healings. A viewing of the Lourdes video deepens understanding of these apparitions, which transformed this humble town into a global pilgrimage destination. A walking tour follows, visiting the Boly Mill, St. Bernadette's birthplace, and the Cachot, a former prison where her impoverished family lived during the apparitions. Pilgrims also see the parish church where St. Bernadette was baptized, connecting with her humble faith. The day includes the opportunity to partake in the healing waters of Lourdes through the water ritual, walking the Way of the Cross, adoring the Blessed Sacrament in Eucharistic Adoration, and engaging in personal devotions. At 5:00 PM, the daily Procession of the Blessed Sacrament and Blessing of the Sick offers a profound moment of grace, followed by another chance to join the evening candlelight procession, uniting pilgrims in prayerful **B & D Lourdes** solidarity.





October 14: This day marks the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, a celebration of Mary's maternal intercession. Holy Mass is celebrated in the Chapel of St. Anne within the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, a sacred space within the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes, built to honor the Virgin's apparitions. The day unfolds as a "miniretreat," with opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which restores pilgrims to grace, walking the Stations of the Cross that reflect Christ's Passion, and Eucharistic Adoration, fostering intimacy with the Lord. At 5:00 PM, the Procession of the Blessed Sacrament and Blessing of the Sick continues to inspire hope and healing. The day concludes with a traditional French farewell dinner, giving thanks for the graces received in this holy place where millions have sought Mary's intercession.

B & D Lourdes

October 15: After breakfast, the group transfers to Toulouse airport for a 1:55 PM flight to Rome, the heart of the Catholic Church. Upon arrival, pilgrims visit St. Paul Outside the Walls, one of Rome's four major basilicas, dedicated to St. Paul, the Apostle of the Gentiles, whose missionary journeys spread Christianity across the ancient world. His tomb, beneath the high altar, is a focal point of devotion. Holy Mass is celebrated here, followed by a tour of the basilica's stunning mosaics and cloister, reflecting centuries of Christian artistry. The group then proceeds to the hotel in Rome for dinner and rest, preparing to explore the Eternal City's sacred heritage.

October 16: After breakfast, the day is marked by Holy Mass in the Crypts of St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the spiritual center of the Catholic Church, built over the tomb of St. Peter, the first Pope. After the group proceeds to the Pantheon, a former pagan temple converted to a church dedicated to St. Mary and the Martyrs in 609 AD, continuing through Old Rome, exploring Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, and the Spanish Steps. The day concludes with dinner at Osteria dei Pontefici, near the Vatican, and an overnight stay at the hotel.

B & D Rome

October 17: The day begins with a visit to Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, housing Passion relics that inspire deep reflection. The group then proceeds to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the largest church dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, founded in the 5th century after the Council of Ephesus proclaimed Mary as Theotokos (Mother of God). Its mosaics and the relic of Christ's Manger inspire devotion, and Holy Mass is celebrated here. Next, the group visits Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Cathedral of Rome and "Mother and Head of all Churches," established by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, followed by a tour of its ornate interior. Lunch at Cecilia Metella Restaurant provides fellowship. The day concludes with an exploration of the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, where early Christians, including popes and martyrs, were buried, and ancient frescoes depict Eucharistic and baptismal themes. Dinner on own tonight.



October 18: The day begins with a guided tour of the Vatican Museums, showcasing the Sistine Chapel's recently renovated Michelangelo frescoes of creation and the Last Judgment, ending with an exploration of St. Peter's Basilica, with its iconic dome and Pietà. If time allows, the group attends the Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square, where the Holy Father delivers an address, prays the Angelus, and imparts the Apostolic Blessing, uniting pilgrims with the universal Church. Next, the group attends Mass at Santa Maria in Trastevere, one of Rome's oldest churches in the vibrant Trastevere district. Its 13th-century golden mosaics depict Mary's life, and ancient Roman columns add historical depth to this serene basilica, a cherished site of early Christian worship. The afternoon offers shopping in Rome's charming boutiques, followed by an evening cooking class on Isola Tiberina, where pilgrims craft ravioli and cavatelli, enjoying a dinner of pasta, green pepper veal mignon, and tiramisu, paired with wine. October 19: After checking out of the Rome hotel, the group travels east to Subiaco to visit the Sanctuary of the Sacro Speco, the "Holy Cave" where St. Benedict of Norcia lived as a hermit in the early 6th century, laying the foundation for Western monasticism through his Rule. Holy Mass is celebrated in this cradle of Benedictine spirituality. The journey continues north to Roccaporena, birthplace of St. Rita of Cascia, known as the "Saint of the Impossible" for her intercession in desperate causes. After her husband's death, she joined an Augustinian community, and her partial stigmata reflects her union with Christ's suffering. Pilgrims visit her 14th-century house, the Miracle Orchard, and the Church of San Montano, where she married. The Scoglio di Santa Rita, her prayer rock, invites contemplation. The group descends to Cascia for dinner outside the hotel.

October 20: After checking out from Cascia, the group travels northwest to Norcia, birthplace of St. Benedict, where they attend the Monastic Mass at the Monastero di San Benedetto, a living testament to Benedictine spirituality despite the region's history of earthquakes. The group visits St. Mary of the Angels, home of the Porziuncola, where St. Francis founded the Franciscan Order, and the site of his death. The group checks into the hotel for dinner and overnight.




October 21: Holy Mass is celebrated in the Basilica of St. Francis (Chapel Santa Caterina), a 13th-century masterpiece housing the saint's tomb and Giotto's frescoes depicting his life of poverty and love for creation. A guided tour of Assisi's holy sites follows, including a visit to the tomb of Saint Carlo Acutis, a young Italian who documented Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions online before his death from leukemia in 2006, inspiring youth to holiness. A visit to a local winery offers a tasting with light fare, followed by dinner at a local restaurant.

B & D Assisi

October 22: The day begins at the Basilica of St. Clare, where pilgrims venerate the Crucifix of San Damiano, from which Christ spoke to St. Francis, commanding him to "Rebuild My Church." St. Clare, foundress of the Poor Clares, is entombed here, her life a testament to radical poverty and prayer. Side excursion to San Damiano convent Holy Mass is celebrated in this sacred space. The rest of the day is free to explore Assisi's spiritual treasures or shop. A farewell dinner at a local restaurant marks the final evening in Assisi.




October 23: Pilgrims depart for Orvieto, a city central to the Church's Eucharistic devotion due to the 1263 Miracle of Bolsena, where a consecrated host bled, affirming the Real Presence and inspiring the Feast of Corpus Christi. At 10:00 AM, a private Holy Mass is celebrated in the Corporal Chapel of the Duomo of Orvieto, a Gothic masterpiece housing the blood-stained corporal relic. Pilgrims venerate this Eucharistic relic and explore the cathedral's frescoes and sculptures, which proclaim salvation history. A guided tour of Orvieto's historical center reveals its medieval Catholic heritage, with churches and traditions reflecting deep faith. A farewell lunch at Le Velette offers reflection on the pilgrimage's graces before the group proceeds to the Hilton FCO Rome for an overnight stay, conveniently located for walking to the airport terminal.

October 24: After breakfast, the group is transferred to Rome's airport for the return flight to the United States, arriving in St. Louis the same day, enriched by the spiritual graces of this sacred journey through sites of Marian, apostolic, and Eucharistic devotion.
