

From there, you'll journey to Croagh Patrick, the holy mountain where St. Patrick is said to have fasted and prayed for 40 days in the 5th century. Known as Ireland's spiritual heart, the mountain is a place of deep pilgrimage, where you can reflect on your faith and the legacy of St. Patrick. After your time at Croagh Patrick, you'll drive to Westport, a picturesque town nestled in the countryside, where you'll check into your hotel. Dinner will be served at your hotel, and you'll enjoy an overnight stay, surrounded by the peace of the Irish landscape.

Your day then continues with a visit to Kylemore Abbey, a Benedictine monastery founded in the 19th century by a wealthy family and later transformed into a place of prayer and retreat by Benedictine nuns. You'll have time to admire the stunning architecture and peaceful gardens of this holy site. The final stop of the day is Galway, a vibrant city known for its artistic atmosphere and Catholic history. After a tour of the city, you'll enjoy dinner outside the hotel before retiring for the night in Galway.


